Data Integration Services (DIS) automates large-file data transfer from your Student Information System to your Scantron assessment system site. Streamline your data processing and get reliable, up-to-date student information faster.

What Is DIS?

DIS is a service solution that extracts, transforms, and loads data from your Student Information System (SIS) into a Scantron assessment system database. When you automate this process, you minimize the time needed for processing, and reduce errors associated with manual data entry.

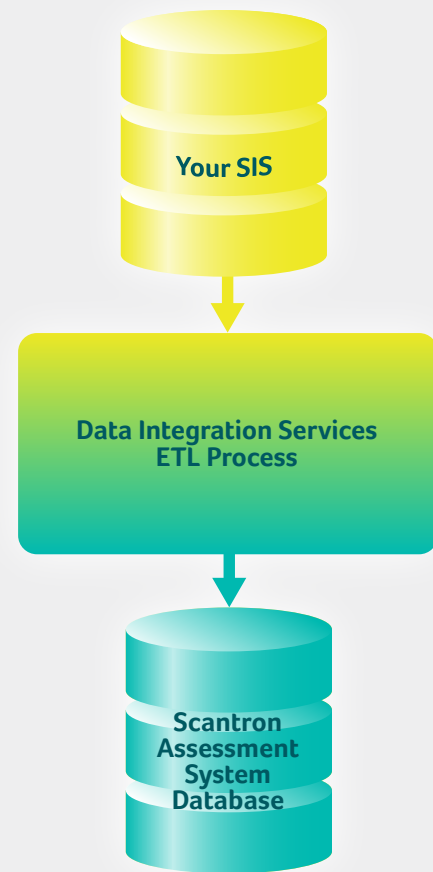
Further, DIS minimizes the volume of data being transferred, processing only those records with changes. By including only changed records, your data transfer is smaller, faster, and more reliable.

With DIS, you get flexible and automated scheduling, a streamlined data aggregation process, and fewer delays in data processing. Student data in your Scantron assessment system is always as current as your SIS, automatically.

DIS can improve your data transfer process if you:

- Require frequent data loads

- Have a data team skilled at generating relational files from your SIS

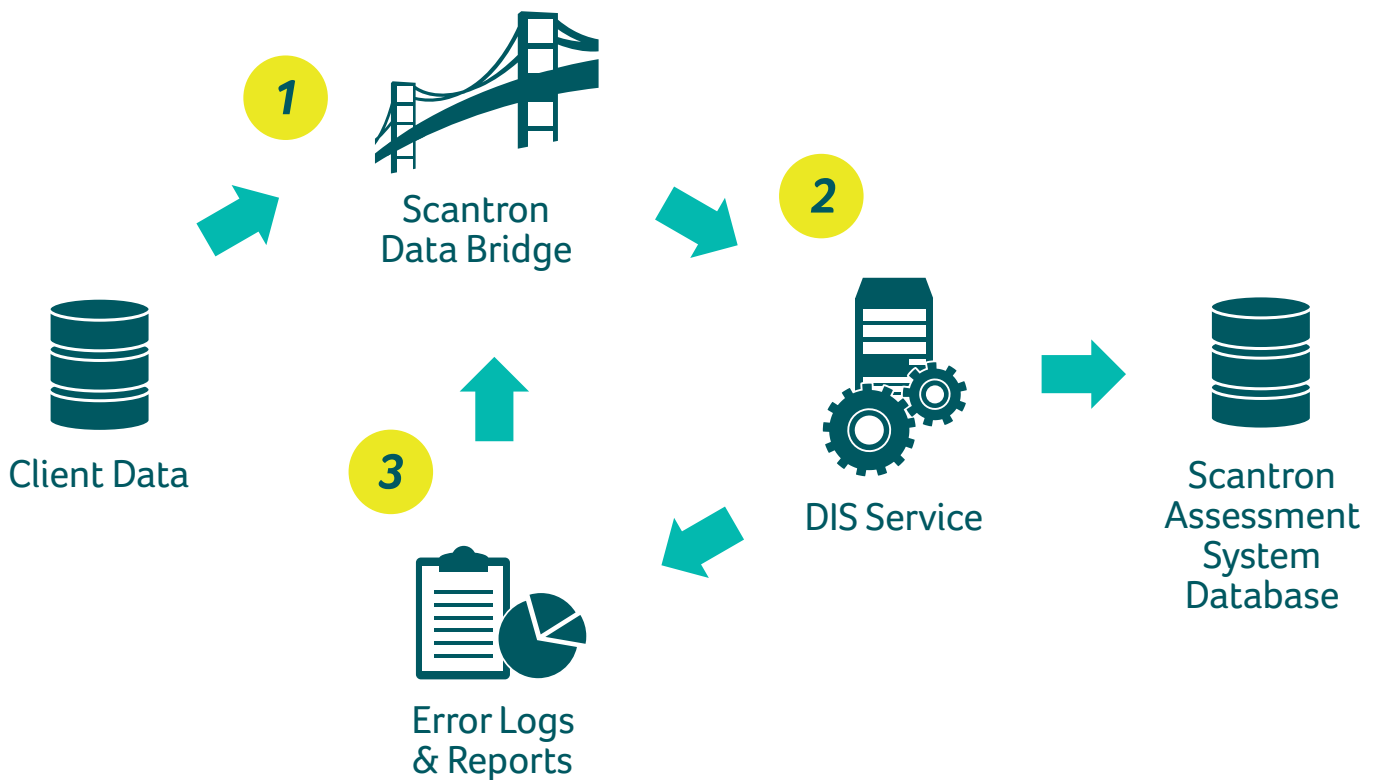

How does Data Integration Services work?

1. Export records from your SIS and upload the files to Scantron's Secure FTP site at <https://databrige.scantron.com>.
2. Scantron processes the incoming data and transfers any changed records into your assessment system database.
3. Scantron places a summary of results and a log of any errors on your Data Bridge site for your review.
